Reasons to Contact the Embassy Abroad:

- Lost or stolen passport – emergency replacement.
- Medical emergencies – doctors, hospitals, evacuation.
- Victim of crime – police, lawyers, notify family.
- Arrest or detention – treatment, legal resources.
- Civil unrest/disasters – safety alerts, evacuation.
- Death abroad – notify family, remains/belongings.
- General help – notary, voting, lost funds/medications.

Travel Tip:

Save both the local embassy number and the crisis line in your phone, and keep them written in your travel wallet for backup.
